<u>Difference #3</u> - The end results.

- v. 47 Assuredly, I say to you that he'll make him <u>ruler</u> over <u>all</u> his goods
- <u>2 Cor. 4:17-18</u> Our light and momentary troubles are producing for us an eternal glory that <u>far outweighs them all</u>. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.
- John 10:9 Jesus said, "I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved
