Trial #1 - Jesus before Annas

John 18:13 - They brought Him *first* to Annas, who was the father-in-law of Caiaphas, the high priest that year.

Deuteronomy 16:18-20 - Appoint judges and officials... in every town the LORD your God is giving you. They are to judge the people with *righteous judgment*. Don't deny justice or show partiality. Don't accept a bribe, for a bribe blinds the eyes of the wise and twists the words of the righteous. Pursue justice, and justice alone, so that you may live, and you may possess the land that the LORD your God is giving you.

Deuteronomy 19:16-19 - "If a malicious witness comes forward and accuses someone of a crime, then both the accuser and accused must appear... The judges must investigate the case thoroughly. If the accuser has brought false charges... you must impose on the accuser the sentence he intended for the other person."

John 18:19 - Annas then questioned Jesus about His disciples, and His doctrine.

2 Corinthians 4:3 - If our gospel is hidden, it's hidden from those who are lost.

John 18:22-24 - Then one of the Temple guards standing nearby slapped Jesus across the face. "Is that the way to answer the high priest?" he demanded. Jesus replied, "If I said something wrong, testify to what was wrong. But if I spoke the truth, why did you strike Me?" Then Annas sent Him, still bound, to Caiaphas the high priest.

Trial #2 - Jesus before Caiaphas.

<u>Matthew 26:59</u> - Now the chief priests, the elders, and all the council sought false testimony against Jesus to put Him to death, but *found none*.

Daniel 7:13 - "I was watching in the night visions, and behold, One like the <u>Son of</u> <u>Man</u>, coming with the clouds of heaven! To Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom."

<u>**2** Tim. 4:1</u> - He will <u>judge</u> the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom.

Psalm 110 - "The Lord is at Your right hand... He shall judge among the nations."

<u>**1** Corinthians 4:5</u> - Judge nothing before the appointed time; wait till the Lord comes. He will bring to light what is hidden in darkness.

<u>Genesis 49:10</u> - The scepter won't depart from <u>Judah</u>, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until He (Messiah) to whom it belongs shall come.

Jewish judicial system:

- **1.** Public trials
- 2. Right of self defense (Witnesses)
- 3. At least two credible witnesses against the accused.
- 4. Executions carried out on the third day.
- 5. Judge couldn't act as prosecutor.
