Acts 2:38 - *Repent* and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins.

<u>Mark 16:15-16</u> - Jesus said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who <u>believes</u> and is baptized...He who does not <u>believe</u> will be condemned.

John 6:47 - "Whoever believes in <u>Me</u> has eternal life."

We're called to be witnesses.

A witness simply tells what they've seen, what they know and what they've experienced.

That's how you witness.

Last week God gave me the opportunity to share the gospel--so I shared my testimony.

The person I spoke to talked about how they had turned their life around and how that would get them to heaven. So I said...

- I used to believe that, but one day I heard something that changed my life
- "All have sinned and come short of the glory of God."
- I was a sinner...
- "God is of purer eyes than to behold iniquity."
- My sin separated me from God...
- But God loved me so much...
- All I had to do was receive the gift God offered me.

When you share your testimony--don't stop there.

Encourage them to respond.

I asked him:

- What do you think about that?
- Have you ever done that?

Jesus said, "Make disciples of *all nations*."

Jim Callahan's devotional this week answers that question perfectly.

Paul's faith was pushed to the limits. He credits the prayers of the Corinthian church for his deliverance from death. Paul experienced the power of a loving church praying for him. We may wonder if our feeble prayers for missionaries far away make any real difference. Paul felt and saw the difference.

So did Joanne and I. We had over 100 committed prayer partners praying daily specific prayer requests for the teens in our dorm in the Philippines. We saw God do such a deep spiritual work in their lives, the other dorm parents at Faith Academy openly marveled at their zeal.

Most of our teens came to a 5:30am prayer meeting before school. Many of them gave up their Sunday afternoons to visit at a leprosy colony and Saturday mornings to run an AWANA club. I know God used those committed prayer partners to impact not just the teens' lives but the adults and children they ministered to.

God has purposed to use <u>our prayers</u> to partner with missionaries, their families and their ministries.
