Luke 24:11 - The story sounded like *nonsense* to them, so they *didn't believe* it.

John 20:6-8 - Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the tomb. He saw the linen cloths lying there, and the face cloth, which had been on Jesus' head, not lying with the linen cloths but folded up in a place by itself. Then the other disciple, who had reached the tomb first, also went in, and he saw and <u>believed</u>.

1. Cleopas was fooled by the Resurrection.

Luke 24:26-27 - "Wasn't it clearly predicted that the Messiah would have to suffer all these things before entering His glory?" And beginning with <u>Moses</u> ... He explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning Himself.

Genesis 22:1 - God *tested* Abraham...

<u>Genesis 22:1-2</u> - God tested Abraham... "Take your son, <u>your only son</u> Isaac, <u>whom</u> <u>you love</u>, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a sacrifice."

<u>Genesis 22:11-14</u> - "Abraham... don't lay your hand on the boy..." Then Abraham looked up and saw a ram caught by its horns in a thicket. So he took the ram and sacrificed it... So Abraham called that place The LORD <u>Will</u> Provide. And to this day it's said, "On the mountain of the LORD it <u>will</u> be provided."

Luke 24:30-31 - As they sat down to eat, He took the bread and blessed it. Then He broke it and gave it to them. Then their eyes were opened and they recognized Him, and He disappeared from their sight.
