Matthew 5:17-19

- Pick a number from 1 to 10

1. Jesus fulfills all the Messianic prophecies.

Psalm 118:22- The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone.

Isaiah 53:3 - He was despised and rejected by men.

Psalm 41:9 - My close friend, whom I trusted, who shared My bread, has turned against Me.

Zech. 11:13 - "Throw it to the potter"--the handsome price at which they valued me! So I took *the thirty pieces of silver and threw them to the potter at the house of the LORD.*

Psalm 22 - Everyone who sees Me mocks Me. They sneer and shake their heads, saying, "He trusts in the LORD, let the LORD rescue Him. Let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him."... I'm poured out like water, and all My bones are out of joint... My tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth... They pierced My hands and My feet... They divide My clothes among them and cast lots for My garment.

Psalm 16:10 - You won't abandon my soul to Sheol, nor will You let Your Holy One see decay.

2. The entire sacrificial system pointed to Jesus.

Genesis 3:7 - *They* sewed fig leaves together and made *themselves* coverings.

Genesis 3:21 - God made clothing from *animal skins* for Adam and his wife.

Hebrews 10:10 - We have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

3. Jesus fulfilled the Law by keeping it perfectly.

Galatians 4:4 - When the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of woman, *born under the law*.

Genesis 6:14-16 - Build an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out. Make the ark 450 feet long, 75 feet wide, and 45 feet high. Make a roof for it, leaving below the roof an opening eighteen inches high all around. Put a door in the side of the ark and make lower, middle and upper decks.

Leviticus 19:18-19 - Don't seek revenge... Love your neighbor as yourself... Don't wear clothing woven from two different kinds of thread.

Leviticus 19:19 - Don't mate two different kinds of animals. Don't plant your field with two different kinds of seed. Don't wear clothing woven from two different kinds of thread.

Romans 10:4 - Christ is *the end of the law*.

Romans 6:14 - *You're not under the law*, but under grace.

Galatians 5:14 - The entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

- 1. Read the OT and look for Jesus on every page.**
- 2. Receive the ultimate sacrifice.**
- 3. Focus on the two commands that Jesus said were the greatest.**
