Intro

Matthew 5:3 - "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of *heaven*."

Matthew 5:17 - "Don't think that I've come to destroy the Law and the Prophets. I didn't come to destroy but to *fulfill*."

Matthew 7:12 - "Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets."

"On the wide road you go wherever you please. On the narrow road you go wherever He pleases."

Luke 5:11 - When they brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed Him.

Jesus said, "I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved." (**John 10:9**)
